Golwg 2020 is an exciting community led initiative which has taken place in Beddgelert and Harlech.

An event held over two days in Beddgelert in 2002 was the first of its kind ever held in Gwynedd – a sustainability fair with a difference. In 2003 the event was repeated at Harlech, with an extra day to cater for local schools.

The aim of Golwg 2020 is to promote sustainable development in an accessible people-friendly way.

A management panel consisting of representatives from the host community, Snowdonia National Park Authority and Sustainable Gwynedd Gynladwy, together with a paid co-ordinator, assume responsibility for organising the event.

The panel works very closely with local community groups, and the event is a showcase for the work done in the community by the voluntary sector.

Golwg 2020 is an open, social event with talks and presentations on issues relating to sustainability that will encourage lively debate.

Stalls and displays increase awareness of the simple choices we can all make to secure a safe future for what is 'our only world'.

Art and music bring a colourful, entertaining and sometimes provocative three-dimensional approach to the event, breaking down barriers and bringing sustainable development to a totally new audience.

*The future:* The management panel are at present seeking funding to arrange a further three annual events in new communities.
